

HOW TO WRITE TESTIMONY FOR A BOARD MEETING

Thank you so much for your interest in speaking at the upcoming HISD Board Meeting! Parent and community voice is incredibly powerful, and HISD leaders want to hear your stories to help inform them about decision-making.

There is power in numbers, and having more parents and community speak on a specific issue will draw more attention to why this policy is important for students. The Parent Action Network wants to support parents in elevating their voices, experiences, and shift the quality of education for their children.

Each speaker who registers to speak generally gets one (1) minute to speak.

Parts of testimony:

- Introduce yourself and thank the board for their time, and thank them for putting students first.
- · Give a brief statement on the issue you are addressing.
- Explain why this issue matters to you and/or what improvement you'd like to see.
- Let the board know what action you'd like to see them take for the district.
- Say thank you once again.

Tips:

For added impact, email your testimony to any of the board members ahead of the meeting you will speak at, and then send a thank you note after.

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
